City of St. Cloud announces Backyard Poultry Basics class for city residents

St. Cloud, Fla. (March 29, 2017) – City of St. Cloud announces its third Backyard Poultry Basics class May 2, 6-7:30 p.m., at St. Cloud Civic Center (3001 17th St.) in Room 2. The free class is for residents who wish to obtain a Temporary Backyard Chicken-Keeping Permit or for residents who would like to attend for educational purposes.

St. Cloud City Council approved Ordinance #2016-36 Sept. 15, 2016, which introduced a two-year pilot program that allows single-family home and duplex residents within the city limits of St. Cloud to keep up to four chickens in their backyard. One of the requirements to obtain the temporary permit is for residents to take a chicken-keeping class. University of Florida Extension Services presents the class to city residents so that each participant learns how to safely and effectively keep chickens in their residence’s backyard.

The class is free of charge for the first 50 people who register by the April 26 deadline. The registration form for the Backyard Poultry Basics class is available online at www.stcloud.org within the Backyard Chicken-Keeping Program [web page](#).

Municipio de St. Cloud anuncia clase para residentes sobre los Fundamentos de Aves Domésticas

St. Cloud, Fla. (29 de marzo del 2017) – El Municipio de St. Cloud anuncia su tercera clase Fundamentos de Aves Domésticas el 2 de mayo, 6-7:30 p.m., en el St. Cloud Civic Center (3001 17th St.) en el salón 2. La clase gratuita es para residentes quienes quieren obtener un Permiso Temporal de Aves Domésticas o para residentes quienes quieren asistir por razones educativas.

El Concilio de la Ciudad de St. Cloud aprobó la Ordenanza #2016-36 el 15 de septiembre del 2016, la cual ha introducido un programa piloto de dos años que le permite a los residentes de St. Cloud de viviendas unifamiliares y dúplex a mantener hasta cuatro gallinas en los patios traseros de sus casas. Uno de los requisitos para obtener el permiso temporal es que los ciudadanos deben completar una clase sobre aves domésticas. University of Florida Extension Services presentará la clase para los residentes de la ciudad para que cada participante aprenda cómo cuidar de gallinas seguramente y eficazmente.
