## City of St. Cloud Parks & Recreation May activities announced

*St. Cloud, Fla. (April 19, 2017)* – The City of St. Cloud Parks and Recreation staff is providing the following activities during the month of May.

**RAYS Swimming** – Recreation Aquatics Youth Swim (RAYS) sessions are scheduled for May 1-25, 9 a.m. or 6 p.m., and May 30-June 22, 9 a.m., 10 a.m. or 6-7 p.m., at Chris Lyle Aquatic Center (3001 17<sup>th</sup> St.). Sessions cost \$50 for Osceola County residents and \$60 for nonresidents. The RAYS program emphasizes good sportsmanship while participating in recreational swimming and helps build confidence and team skills. This is a beginning swim team focusing on technique.

**Garden Class** – This Urban Agriculture Program class will be offered to people ages 14 and up May 6, 10 a.m.-12:30 p.m., at PegHorn Nature Park and Trail (2101 PegHorn Way). The theme for this class will be *Cooling Down with Summer Foods and Herbs*. The different herbs and foods that can be used during the summer months will be discussed during the class, along with some recommended summer drinks. The cost is \$8 per person.

**Youth Basketball** – This year's Ron Riley Youth Basketball League's Showcase Evaluation is scheduled for May 6, 9 a.m.-5 p.m., at the Civic Center (3001 17<sup>th</sup> St.). The draft is set for May 8-10, 6:30-9:30 p.m., in the Civic Center's Gym B. Practice starts May 15, 6:30-9:30 p.m., at the Civic Center.

**Little Ladies Tea Party** – This popular annual event is set for May 6, 1-3 p.m., at the Marina Building Banquet Hall (1104 Lakeshore Blvd.) for ages 2 and up. The cost is \$10 per person. Snacks and tea will be available and attendees will enjoy arts and crafts, story time, music and a fashion show for little girls to participate in. Tickets must be purchased at the Civic Center in advance.

**Swim Lessons** – Online registration at <https://webtrac.stcloud.org> opens May 8 for swim lessons that run May 22-25 and May 30-June 1. Online registration at <https://webtrac.stcloud.org> opens May 22 for swim lessons that run June 5-8 and June 12-15.

**Movie Matinee** – May's movie is *Quartet* (rated PG-13) May 10, 12:30 p.m., at St. Cloud Community Center (3101 17<sup>th</sup> St.). Free movie for people ages 18 and up. Popcorn, soda and snacks are available for purchase.

**Movie at the Lakefront** – May's movie is *Beauty and the Beast* (rated PG) and it is set for May 12, starting at sunset, at Lakefront Park (1104 Lakeshore Blvd.). A family movie is shown every month on a giant inflatable movie screen. This monthly program is free to the community.

**Bluegrass Jam** – Bluegrass Jam at PegHorn Nature Park & Trail is set for May 13, 1-3:30 p.m., for people of all ages. This is a free event and everyone is welcome and encouraged to bring their instruments and to enjoy this genre of music. Or just bring a chair and enjoy the sounds!

**Strength Camp** – Registration for an All Sports Speed and Strength Camp is set for May 15, 9:30-11:30 a.m., at the Civic Center. A weekly camp is scheduled for June 12-16 and for June 19-25 for children 5 years old (with kindergarten completed) and up to 16 years old. Costs are \$50 for Osceola County residents and \$60 for nonresidents.

**Marina Building Banquet Hall Open House** – May 17, 4-7 p.m. The Marina Building Banquet Hall is located at 1104 Lakeshore Blvd., second floor.

**Munchkin Adventure** – This event is set for May 25, 9-11 a.m., at the Civic Center for children 2-5 years old. It features games, treats and a bounce house with a princess and pirate theme. The cost is \$5 per child.

**Summer Camp** – A 2017 Adventure Summer Camp Parent Information Night is set for May 25, 6-7 p.m., in the Civic Center's Gym A. Parents will be able to pick their child's T-shirt and ask questions about this year's summer camp.

**S.O.S.** – Splash for Our Kids' Safety (S.O.S.) is set for May 27, 12-5 p.m., at the Chris Lyle Aquatic Center. This annual event helps reinforce water safety throughout the community and is open to all ages. The cost is \$3 for Osceola County residents and \$4 for nonresidents.

**Lifeguard Class** – A lifeguard class is scheduled for May 27-28 and June 3-4, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., at Chris Lyle Aquatic Center for ages 15 and up. The total fee is \$275 per student.
