

**TABLE "A"**  
**Solid Waste Collection and Transfer Station Schedule of Fees and Charges**

PART 1

(a) The following schedule of rates for the collection of solid waste by the City of St. Cloud, Florida is hereby adopted:

Class I: Residential Curbside Collection

1. \$17.85 per month.
2. Additional garbage and yard waste carts may be requested for a onetime charge of \$100 each.
3. An additional charge of \$1.00 for each item placed at the curb outside the 96 gallon cart shall be automatically assessed on the utility bill.
4. A roll-back charge of \$5.00 may be assessed if the cart is not rolled back in by the end of that collection day.
5. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for nonrecyclables placed in recyclable carts or for nonyard waste placed in yard waste carts.
6. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for hazardous materials placed in garbage, yard waste or recyclable carts.

Class II: Commercial Curbside Collection.

1. \$17.85 per month.
2. Additional garbage and yard waste carts may be requested for a onetime charge of \$100 each.
3. An additional charge of \$1.00 for each item placed at the curb outside the 96 gallon cart shall be automatically assessed on the utility bill.
4. A roll-back charge of \$5.00 may be assessed if the cart is not rolled back in by the end of that collection day.
5. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for nonrecyclables placed in recyclable carts or for nonyard waste placed in yard waste carts.
6. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for hazardous materials placed in garbage, yard waste or recyclable carts.

Class III: Commercial Dumpster Collection

1. \$6.00 per cubic yard of container per collection.
  - a. Exception: Downtown Business Beautification Program - Those participating businesses shall be billed a monthly average based upon previous charges, calculated on prior year; new businesses or changes in business status shall be analyzed on a case-by-case basis by the solid waste superintendent. If new business or changes in business status occurs the solid waste superintendent shall rely on previous records of similar types of businesses to implement a monthly charge.
2. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for hazardous materials placed in dumpsters.

- Class IV: Roll-Off Containers  
Available In City Only:
1. \$100 pull charge per roll-off container, plus current tipping rate according to weight.
    - a. Containers not pulled within two weeks of delivery will automatically be pulled
    - b. Customer may request an extension for an additional \$5.00 per day. Not to exceed \$25.00 per week
  2. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for hazardous materials placed in roll-off container.

Class V: Residential Dumpster Rentals.

1. Residential dumpster rentals will be for garbage/trash only. No construction or demolition materials.
2. \$50.00 weekly rental charge per residential dumpster container plus current tipping rate according to yardage..
3. A \$20.00 separation fee shall be assessed for hazardous materials placed in residential dumpster container.

(b) The minimum collection fee for both Class II and Class III shall be the equivalent of Class I rate.

(c) Limited fee waiver

When the owner of the building is also the proprietor of the business occupying the facility and has two or more businesses operating under his or her proprietorship on the site, the requirement for the minimum collection fee may be waived for those additional accounts. This does not apply to separate businesses owned by other than the sponsoring proprietor.

(d) Where more than one business or customer uses the mechanical collection bins (dumpsters) provided by the city, the additional user(s) shall be co-applicant and co-signatory for service. Billing for service shall be to the primary signature (applicant) with payment made by either. Multiple use of containers is limited to those customers located on the same site (property parcel).

(e) Where the owner of a commercial building has residential apartments, boarding rooms etc. on the same site with a separate electric meter the residential monthly rate will come into effect, curbside collection may be used, or the mechanical collection may be used with the permission of the primary signature (applicant) and limited to those residential customers on site.

(f) Special pickup

Separated materials:

Minimum charge for volume up to 3'x3'x6' (2 cubic yards):

Yardwaste, white goods & other household items.... \$12.00

Additional charge per cubic yard (3'x3'x3')..... \$6.50

Commingled (mixed piles) materials:

Minimum charge for volume up to 3'x3'x6' (2 cubic yards):

Commingled special pickup..... \$24.00

Additional charge per cubic yard (3'x3'x3')..... \$13.00

Special pick-ups over an estimated 8 (eight) cubic yards will be charged by current tipping rate according to weight.

Where the property owner, occupant and/or tenant places, deposits or allows the placement or deposits of refuse out for special pickup by the city without making prior appointment for city pickup, it will be presumed that the placement is an order for city pickup in accordance with the rules and conditions previously set forth. Any items left curbside for three (3) or more days shall be removed by the city and the owner assessed the appropriate fee(s).

The solid waste driver/collector shall determine by estimating the quantity of special waste to be collected.

PART 2

Transfer Station use charges:

(a) All users of the City Transfer Stations shall pay at the following rates:

(1) Cars - \$2.25

(2) Tires: Limit of four (4) tires per trip.

a. Car and light truck tires 20" and smaller: \$3.15 per tire

b. Heavy truck tires 22.5" and below: \$12.60 per tire

c. Tires over 22.5" not accepted.

(3) All vehicles are \$0.0242 dollars per pound (\$48.51/ton), with a minimum charge of \$2.25. Any individual entity or customer bringing more than 200 tons total of MSW (Municipal Solid Waste), over a one month period shall be charged (\$46.48/ton). Mixed waste shall be \$0.0317 dollars per pound (\$63.51/ton).

(4) \$5.00 "weighing charge" per vehicle, for each determination or certification of weight at the city weigh scale.

(b) All private entity users of the city transfer station who wish to be billed monthly for their actual usage must provide a surety deposit equal to two (2) months worth of projected usage.

(c) If at any time that the Transfer Station should incur a user tax or any type of surcharge on waste disposal charges the fees referred to in (a)(3) may be increased accordingly but not more than the additional tax or surcharge amount.

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PART 3

Prepayment Fees:

(a) Class I or Class II curbside pickup deposit.....\$100.00

\*Deposit amounts (Prepayments) can be required as outlined in Section 36-45 in situations where a higher risk is determined to exist and the customer does not have potable water service.
