CONDITIONS

- 1.) This permit shall expire by limitation and become null and void if the work authorized is not commenced within six (6) months from the date indicated by the applicant under "...scheduled to begin on." (utility permit); or as shown on the permit under "...the work shall be completed by the last calendar day of...," (culvert permit). This permit can also be made null and void at any time, for just cause, as determined by the City Council, City Manager, and/or the City Engineer.
- 2.) It is understood and agreed that the rights and privileges herein set out are granted only to the extent of the City's right, title and interest in the land to be entered upon and used by the permittee and the permittee will, at all times, assume all risk of an indemnify, defend, and save harmless the City of St. Cloud from and against all loss, damage, cost or expense arising in any manner on account of exercise or attempted exercise by the permittee.
- 3.) The construction and/or maintenance of a utility shall not interfere with the property and rights of a prior occupant.
- 4.) All materials and equipment shall be subject to inspection by the City Engineer and/or designee.
- 5.) All property shall be restored to its original condition or better, as far as practical, including repair of any damage or injury to the road, highway, or parkway by reason of the work, and to repair said road, highway or parkway at least equal or better than that condition which existed immediately prior to the infliction of such damage or injury.
- 6.) Required sketches, drawings, plan and cross-section, covering details of this work shall be attached to and become a part of this permit. Any changes made to the sketches, drawings and plans or stipulations made thereon shall become a part of the approval.
- 7.) Any awning permitted by a building permit within the CDB-1 zoning district may install support poles within the Right-of-Way between the back of curb and the main structure. The property owner is responsible for any costs incurred should underground utility/maintenance be required at a future date in the right-of-way and the awning or awning support poles are damaged or destroyed.
- 8.) In the event of widening, repair or reconstruction of such road or highway, upon reasonable notice, the permittee shall move its facilities to clear such construction at no cost to the City of St. Cloud, insofar as such facilities are within the public right-of-way.
- 9.) All overhead installations shall conform to clearance standards of the State of Florida Department of Transportation. All underground crossing installations under roadways or traveled ways shall be laid at a minimum depth of 36 inches below the road surface and at least 30 inches below the existing ditch grade. Exceptions will be made only on authority of the City Engineer.
- 10.) Applicant declares that prior to commencing proposed work, filing this permit he has ascertained the location of all existing utilities, both aerial and underground shall be ascertained. Applicant also declares that notice of proposed work under this permit will be furnished each utility involved, prior to commencement of proposed work.
- 11.) It is expressly stipulated that this permit is a license for permissive use only and that the placing of facilities upon the public property pursuant to this permit shall not operate to create or to vest any property right in said holder.
- 12.) The holder of this permit shall take such safety measures, including the placing and display of caution signs and signals as are required by the Florida Department of Transportation Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, and shall prevent obstructions or conditions, which are or may become dangerous to the traveling public.
- 13.) When a permit application is submitted, three (3) sets of plans (work being done) and profiles need to be submitted with the application. One (1) set will be returned with permit. Please submit additional sets if required.
- 14.) When a permit application is submitted for an irrigation system, a permit will be issued with the understanding that the property owner is responsible for any costs incurred should underground utility/maintenance be required a future date in the right-of-way and irrigation system is damaged or destroyed.
